“On the director’s clapper board, we wrote [guest of honour] favourite Christmas movie. Did you spot it? What’s the film?”

Question 4: The Disney Tee

“At the ‘Memory Lane’ table, there’s a photo of [guest of honour] chilling on the sofa in a Disney t-shirt. Can you remember which character was on it?”

Question 5: The Glasses Test

“During dinner, a waiter or waitress popped in to check on us. Quick memory check, were they wearing glasses?”

Question 6: The Sticker Surprise

“Most of you came in through the back entrance. Before you arrived, I stuck a sticker on the door. Any guesses what the sticker was?”

Question 7: The Newspaper Detail

“In our ‘Price is Right’ game, you guessed the ;year] price of a newspaper. But do you remember which newspaper it was?”

Question 8: The House Hunt

“Still in the ‘Price is Right’ game, you guessed the cost of a house when [guest of honour] was born. But did anyone notice the colour of the front door on that house?”
